Kenyenyeva Orphan Project Update

It has been one year since we at First English Lutheran Church became aware of the drought and subsequent starvation occurring in Malawi. We responded with an outpouring of our money and prayers. In the past year we have been able to help the Kenyenyeva Orphan Project build a permanent food storage facility, purchase seed, fertilizer, cooking utensils, plates and other supplies to help feed the local orphans and their care givers. The initial monetary investment to help this orphan project be successful is complete. Thank you to all who have donated money to help to make this happen.

Now that the Kenyenyeva Orphan Project has the basics that they need in order to operate successfully, they still need our monetary and prayer support. Word and Deed International estimates that it will take \$2,000/quarter to help continue the support of this orphan project.

In response to some questions about the funding of this ministry, the only money that we send to Malawi is the money that is specifically earmarked to go there. For example, if \$700 is put into the *Mansfield for Malawi* account in one quarter, then we send \$700 for that quarter.

Your money is only put in the *Mansfield for Malawi* account if MANSFIELD FOR MALAWI is written on your check or if your donation is in an offering envelope and MANSFIELD FOR MALAWI is written on the envelope.

Prayerfully consider helping us to meet our goal of \$2,000 for this next quarter.
